





Important Information

- Influenza like illness (ILI) is still above baseline in Los Angeles County
- Late season influenza peaks are not uncommon
- RSV decreased from 36 cases to 18 cases from week 8 to week 9

In the News

New Study Shows that Vaccinating Children Two Years and Older Cuts Their Rate of Infection by Half

Full vaccination (2 doses) provided protection against laboratory confirmed influenza among children aged 6 to 59 months during a season with suboptimal vaccine match. No vaccine effectiveness was identified with partial vaccination among children aged 6 to 23 months, affirming that children need to be fully vaccinated to obtain protective effects.

Influenza Activity: CA & USA

California: Inpatient ILI data in Southern California decreased in Week 8 (2/18-2/24/07). Statewide, outpatient ILI decreased slightly and influenza activity remained regional.

United States: Influenza activity remained elevated during week 8. Regional or widespread activity increased from 38 states in week 7 to 44 states in week 8.
