



- •For the second week, all markers of influenza activity increased in Los Angeles
- •Twice as many flu isolates have been recorded this year versus all of last year. In the News

A CDC study revealed that <70% of physicians are testing patients for influenza and many are still using amantadine and rimantadine for patients with ILI though those are not currently recommended in the US.

## Influenza Activity: CA & USA

California: During week (1/13/08-1/19/08), influenza activity in California was Regional. ILI admissions decreased in Northern and Southern California but prescriptions for antivirals increased. For more information see the CA influenza report:
