





## **Important Information**

- •Several outbreaks of ILI have been reported in schools and nursing homes
- Otherwise, reports of influenza and influenzalike illness have stabilized
- Ensure that nursing home residents (and staff) are immunized

- •Oseltamivir (Tamiflu)
