










#### **Important Information**

- •ILI activity continues to be high but is leveling off in Los Angeles County.
- •Influenza B activity is almost as high as influenza A.



#### In the News

- •22 children have died in the US due to influenza this season (http://www.cdc.gov/flu/weekly/)
- •Experts are still recommending vaccination, even late in the season
- Vaccines are still available

### Influenza Activity: CA & USA

**United States:** The level of influenza activity increased throughout the US during week 7 (2/17/08-2/23/08). 49 states reported **widespread** influenza.
