PrEP Front Desk Info



Every member of your team, including front desk staff, should know that PrEP exists and is offered by your clinic. Here are a few quick facts about PrEP:

- PrEP stands for Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP). The word "prophylaxis" means to take action to prevent the spread of disease.
- PrEP is a medication (taken as a pill or injection) that prevents HIV.
- PrEP has been shown to reduce the risk of HIV acquisition by up to 99% when taken as prescribed.
- PrEP is for all sexually active adults and adolescents. People who are at risk of HIV acquisition through sex or injection drug use should be strongly encouraged by their provider to take PrEP.
- PrEP is fully covered by most health insurance plans, including Medi-Cal and Medicare.
