
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## Annual Diagnoses of HIV (Reporting Incidence)



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


## Annual Diagnoses of AIDS, HIV Infection and HIV-related Deaths, LAC 1992-2012






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
Comparison of Cumulative HIV Cases (n=80,115) and Cases Diagnosed in 2011 (n=1,880), by Age at Diagnosis – LA County




## **Percent Perinatal HIV Transmission by Birth** Year, LA County, 1996 – 2012




#### Diagnoses of HIV Infection among Adults and Adolescents, by Sex, 2008–2011—United States and 6 Dependent Areas






#### Diagnoses of HIV Infection among Adults and Adolescents, by Race/Ethnicity, 2008–2011—United States and 6 Dependent Areas






#### Diagnoses of HIV Infection among Adults and Adolescents, by Sex and Race/Ethnicity, 2011—United States and 6 Dependent Areas





# **Comparison of Persons Diagnosed with HIV in 2011, by Sex at Birth and Race/Ethnicity - LAC**




#### Rates of Diagnoses of HIV Infection among Adults and Adolescents, by Sex and Race/Ethnicity, 2011—United States





#### Rates of HIV Diagnoses Among Adult/Adolescent Men, by Race/Ethnicity\*, LAC, 2006-2011




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#### Rates of HIV Diagnoses Among Adult/Adolescent Women, by Race/Ethnicity\*, LAC, 2006-2012


#### Diagnoses of HIV Infection among Adults and Adolescents, by Transmission Category, 2008–2011—United States and 6 Dependent Areas


Percent HIV Diagnoses Among Adults/Adolescents by Transmission Category\* and Year of Diagnosis Los Angeles County, 1996-2011

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
Adults and Adolescents Living with Diagnosed HIV Infection, by Sex and Transmission Category, Year-end 2010— United States and 6 Dependent Areas


## **Transmission Category\* for Persons Diagnosed with HIV, by Sex at Birth in Los Angeles County, 2011\*\***

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New HIV Diagnoses in 2009-2011 by Zip code and Service Planning Area in LAC as of Dec. 31, 2012 (N=6,612)



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## **2013 Estimated Number of Persons Living with HIV in Los Angeles County**



(1) Estimate that 18.1% of HIV+ in LA County are unaware of their infection; from CDC estimate.

(2) Of 4,200 notifications pending investigation, estimate about 2,000 who have detectable VL or confirmatory test to be unduplicated cases.



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
### Number of Persons Reported Living with HIV Infection and AIDS by Year, LAC, 1992-2012






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
## Current Age of Persons Living with HIV in LAC (n=45,474)




#### Percent Persons Living with AIDS and HIV Whose Current Age is 50+ Years – by Year, LAC, 2005-12




## **Comparison of Persons Living with HIV, by Gender and Race/Ethnicity, 2011 - LAC**




#### Proportion of Persons Living with HIV/AIDS by Race/Ethnicity and Sex, LAC 2011




## American Indian/Alaskan Natives Living with HIV by Sex, Age and Risk LAC 2011 (N=212\*)




## Persons Living with HIV in LAC per 100,000 population\* by Race/Ethnicity, 2011




## **Prevalence (per 100,000 pop.) of Persons with** HIV by Sex and Race/Ethnicity-LAC, 2010







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

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



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## **Report:** Los Angeles County Transgender Population Estimates 2012

- Input from 4 reports and Transgender Community
- Estimate 14,428 transgender persons living in LAC (Range 7,214 21,642)
- 7,214 Transgender Men; HIV prevalence 0.6%
- 7,214 Transgender Women; HIV prevalence 15.1%
  - African American/Black (48.3%)
  - Native Americans (26.9%)
  - Latinas (17.1%)
  - Whites (4.6%)
  - Asian/Pacific Islanders (3.7%)
