






### People Who Use Drugs & STD/HIV Risk

Complex and variable, but some associations. PWUD generally more likely to have:

- Multiple sex partners
- Reduced condom use
- Transactional sex
- Reduced inhibitions
- "Traumatic" sex (if using stimulants, due to longer &/or more vigorous sex)




### Harm Reduction: Definitions

Harm reduction is a set of practical strategies and ideas aimed at reducing negative consequences associated with drug use.

Harm Reduction is also a movement for social justice built on a belief in, and respect for, the rights of people who use drugs.






### Methamphetamine & Related Harm Reduction Strategies



### **Methamphetamine (Meth)**

- Structurally similar to amphetamine, a common treatment for ADHD
  - Amphetamine Brands: Adderall, Benzedrine, Dexidrine
  - Effects of Methamphetamine Stronger
- Primary Effects:
  - Increased Energy + Alertness
  - Decreased Appetite
  - Euphoria





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
