Discussion/Action Steps

Law enforcement updates and review of their EPO Brochure. Alyson Messenger updated that they are still seeing short term EPOs issued for only 5-7 days. Will collect more data.

Rachelle reviewed RAAP pointers and reviewed LA Court Connect's transition to TEAMS, which will be completed by 6/10/21.

Discussion of limitations of CLETS and CARPOS – may be administered by CA Atty General's Office but is a DOJ Program. **Diane** Trunk notes that it seems that the data fields are not connecting to one another, e.g. CLETS may be asking for a 2 digit day and four digit year and CARPOS is a 2 digit year. We are interested in analyzing the inconsistencies, if any, and may be able to advocate for changes with the Judicial Council. Marie will check what these each look like so we can compare.

Per LASD, mandatory fields that must be completed are:

- Filed Stamp
- Court of Issuance
- Court Case Number
- Full Name of Protected Persons
- Retrained Persons Full Name
- DOB or Approx. Age of Restrained Person
- Expiration Date
- Issue Date
- Magistrates Signature
- Court Seal/certification

Per Amanda, Sheriffs are no longer require a wet signature – the wet signature can be faxed or emailed to someone who then walks it in.
