Our Strategic Planning Process

- 1. Consultant was funded by TCE to work with Asthma Coalitions in the CAFA network
- 2. Began with a Coalition Self-assessment in 2008
- 3. Steering Committee Retreats were held for SP development
- 4. Results of the Assessment and draft SP were presented to the Coalition
- 5. Official inception of the SP took place at the July 2010 Coalition Meeting.

- 1. Set goal to have SP updated by 2/29/12
- 2. Created a plan to re-engage workgroups (today's activity)
- 3. Established a fundraising committee to work on Coalition sustainablilty
- 4. Generated a list of potential new Coalition members

- Convened 4 successful Asthma Coalition Meetings

- Provided public testimony at the SCAG Regional Meeting

Indoor Air Workgroup

Goal:

Promote indoor air quality and asthma friendly housing systems and policies within a framework that upholds human rights and protects against unintended consequences.



Indoor Air Workgroup

Progress to Date:

- 1. Met four times in 2011
- Representatives from Queenscare Family Clinic, Esperanza Community Housing Corp., St. John's Well Child & Family Center, LAC Tobacco Control, Maternal Child & Adolescent Health, Child Health & Disability Prevention
- 3. Submitted letters of support for SB 136 (Smoking Cessation), SB 575 (Close the loopholes for Smokefree workplaces)
- 4. Wrote and submitted IAQ blog post to UCLA Health Databytes

Indoor Air Workgroup

Proposed Objectives for 2012:

- Identify and support/oppose areas of policy that affect indoor air quality in schools, homes, and workplaces.
- Partner and support other coalition workgroups in cross-cutting issues (ie. IAQ in schools)



Clinical Care Workgroup

Goal:

Increase access to and improve quality of care

Progress to Date:

- 1. Not able to meet in 2011 despite multiple scheduling efforts. Possible reasons for this include: difficulty in scheduling during office hours; unpredictable attendance after-hours; unclear direction to the committee.
- 2. Consensus is there is a significant need for a Clinical Workgroup

Clinical Care Workgroup

Potential Objectives for 2012:

- 1. Promote insurance payment funding streams for asthma patient education
- 2. Approach the organization that certifies "Asthma Educators" to create a tiered system for certification
- 3. Educate physicians and other professionals about clinical guidelines for asthma care
- 4. Promote establishment of pilot programs for lay "asthma coaches" and "asthma peer mentors for teenagers"

Outdoor Air Workgroup

Goal:

Improve outdoor air quality

Progress to Date:

Provided letters of support for several policy efforts:

- EPA Clean Air Transport and Hazardous Air Rule
- California's landmark Low Carbon Fuel Standard
- Smoke-free Long Beach Parks



Outdoor Air Workgroup

Potential Objectives for 2012:

- Continue engagement with the Clean Cars Campaign
- 2. Support policies aimed at expanding bicycling, walking, and public transit options
- 3. Promote policies and education to further reduce smoking prevalence and expand smoke-free outdoor areas

Asthma Friendly Schools Workgroup

Goal:

Collaborate and develop methods to improve asthma management in schools.

Progress to Date:

- 1. AAP school nurse survey 2011
- 2. LAUSD Medication Bulletin
- 3. PUSD Asthma Management Policy
- 4. Met monthly with a pre-planned agenda
- 5. Strengths: Passionate individuals with common goals
- 6. Challenges: budget cuts, conflicting work schedules

Asthma Friendly Schools Workgroup

Proposed Objectives for 2012:

- LAUSD will begin to develop an Asthma Management bulletin/policy
- Obtain School Board approval for PUSD asthma management policy
