LAMB Follow Up Data Snapshot, Los Angeles County, 2016

Technical Notes

LAMB Follow Up Project utilizes similar methods as states that conduct Pregnancy Risk Assessment Monitoring System (PRAMS) follow up surveys.1 The Project surveys all mothers who responded to the LAMB survey in 2014. Mothers are contacted by mail only, but telephone interview option is also available if mother requests. The survey can be administered in English, Spanish, and, with translators, available for other languages.

₁BMI calculated from reported weight and height at follow-up. BMI categories are "underweight" (BMI is less than 18.5), "normal" (BMI is 18.5-24.9), "overweight" (BMI is 25 to 29.9), and "obese" (BMI is 30 and over).

²Question asked: How many cigarettes do you smoke on an average day now? (A pack has 20 cigarettes.) Respondents who indicated 0 were categorized as non-smokers, while all others are grouped as those who do smoke.

³Question asked: During the past 30 days, how many times did you drink 4 alcoholic drinks or more in a two hour time span? Respondents who answered one or more times were coded as "binge drinking alcohol."

4Question asked: Are you or your husband or partner doing anything now to keep from getting pregnant?

⁵Question asked: Since your two-year old was born, did you have any of these problems? Check all that apply. Respondents who marked "depression" were coded as "yes" for self-reported depression.

⁶Question asked: Since your two-year old was born, did you have any of these problems? Check all that apply. Respondents who marked "anxiety" were coded as "yes" for self-reported anxiety.

⁷Question asked: In the past 12 months, have any of the following things happened to you? Respondents who marked yes for "I was homeless" were coded as homeless.

8High fruit/vegetable consumption if 5-7 days of vegetables & fruits (fresh, frozen OR canned) per week.

9Child in exercise/active play 1 or more hrs per day.

10Toddlers who are read to/look at books 4 or more times per week.

11Toddlers who are taken on an outing 4 or more times per week.

12If mom responded yes to Q50e getting home visits by a nurse or other health care worker during last pregnant in 2014 LAMB or yes to Q25. During the child's first year, did a health care worker such as a nurse, or social worker provided home visit about parenting in 2016 LAMB Follow Up.

13If the doctor or health care provider had done all three of the following (1) had the child rollover, pick up small objects, stack blocks, throw a ball or recognize different colors; (2) had mother fill out a check list of mom's concerns about child's learning, development or behavior; and (3) had mom fill out a survey or checklist about activities that the child may be able to do, for example, use 2-word phrases, walk steadiy and etc.)
