
New Masking Requirement

New Health Officer Order will require masking indoors **regardless of vaccination status**


- Will go into effect at 11:59pm on Saturday night, July 17th
- Exceptions will apply (similar to masking requirements in place prior to June 15th)



Percentage of Sequenced Specimens That Were Delta Variant by Week of Sequenced Specimen Collection Date, LAC


Delta Variant, Cases and Percentage of Specimens Sequenced, by Week of Specimen Collection

Post-Vaccination Infections Among LAC Cases Tested for Variants Among Specimens Collected June 2021





First Doses Administered Weekly Among All Eligible Persons








Vaccination Sites in LA County

Mobile Vaccine Units in LA County





Covid Among Fully Vaccinated People in LAC

As of July 13, 2021

Of fully vaccinated people:

- 0.09% tested positive
- 0.0045% hospitalized for Covid
- 0.0005% died

Protecting Children from Covid

- New K-12 guidance from state requiring everyone inside schools to wear a face covering
- The risk to children for severe illness and hospitalization is low but not zero
- Preventing transmission in children prevents transmission in adults
