


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Number of COVID-19 Cases by Episode Date, Hospitalizations and Deaths by Date of Death

March 1, 2020 – August 25, 2021




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
Covid Among Fully Vaccinated People in LAC as of August 31, 2021


















Proportion of LAC Communities Vaccinated with ≥ 1 Dose July 29th and August 29th, 2021

DPH's In-Home Vaccination program offers home visits for COVID-19 vaccination to homebound people

People can self-refer or be referred by caregivers, family/loved-ones, providers, organizations, or other sources

2,000 homebound LA County residents vaccinated through this program to date



Assess your personal risk
