



Cumulative 7-Day Cases Per 100,000 by Pediatric Age Group March 1, 2020 – September 1, 2021







DPH Case Investigators


- For all cases, DPH Case Investigators collect student's household and community contacts
- Case Investigators interview cases and provide resources to the case and their family

DPH Contact Tracers

- For students involved in outbreaks and clusters of 3+ students, student's school contacts are imported into the DPH system
- Contact Tracers interview contacts and provide them with resources




