

## March 1, 2020 – September 29, 2021



\*Excludes partially vaccinated (3% of cases)



\*Excludes partially vaccinated (3% of deaths)







# Lambda and Mu Variants, Cases by Week of Specimen Collection




# Chronic Conditions among People Who Died Due to Covid Infection by Vaccination Status, May 1 - October 2, 2021







## New Vaccine Requirements at LAC Establishments

What establishment types?	Who is affected?	What do I need to show?	What goes into effect when?
Bars, lounges, nightclubs, breweries, wineries, and distilleries	Everyone 12 or older	vaccine record card OR health record OR digital vaccination record AND Photo ID	10/7/21: Proof of $\geq 1$ dose + photo ID  11/4/21: Proof of full vaccination + photo ID
Outdoor mega events	Everyone 12 or older	vaccine record card OR health record OR digital vaccination record AND Photo ID (for 18+, beginning 11/1/21)	10/7/21: Proof of full vaccination or recent negative test  11/1/21: Proof of full vaccination or recent negative test + photo ID
