



# Find a COVID-19 Vaccine Site Near You!

## COVID-19 Vaccine is free and available to anyone age 5 and older!

- Vaccines are available at hundreds of different locations across LA County including clinics, pharmacies, pediatrician's offices, worksites, schools, places of worship, metro stations, and parks. No appointment is needed at many locations.
- Free transportation is available to and from some vaccination sites. People who cannot leave their homes can request in-home vaccination.
- Health insurance is not required for vaccines or testing. You do not need to be a US citizen and you will not be asked about immigration status.

## 2 Easy Ways to Get Vaccinated in Los Angeles County:

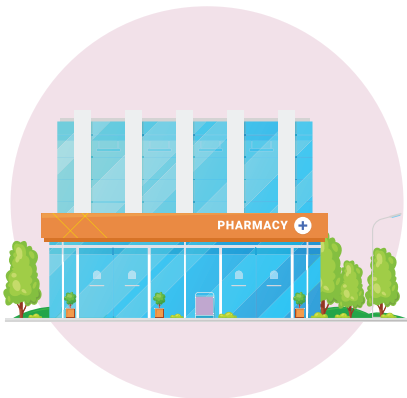
You and your loved ones can make an appointment or find locations where you don't need an appointment:

1. Visit **VaccinateLACounty.com** and Click on "Click here to get vaccinated". Use the search feature to find a location, see which types of vaccines are offered, and much more.

OR

2. Call the **Vaccine Call Center** at **833-540-0473**. The phone line is open daily from 8:00 am to 8:30 pm. Transportation or home visits can be requested here.

You can also call 2-1-1 which is open 24/7 and has information in many languages.



## For persons age 5 -17, Pfizer is the only available vaccine.

For children age 5-11, check that the site has the Pfizer vaccine for 5-11 year-olds. It is a lower dose.

- At sites run by Public Health, minors need consent from a parent or guardian.
- For sites run by other organizations, be sure to check parent/guardian consent and other requirements for that location.

**People under age 5 cannot get vaccinated at this time.**
