

WELLNESS CLINIC EVENTS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Wellness Clinic Events are mobile clinics offering FREE health and social safety net services at school.



What types of services do Wellness Clinics provide?

Services vary by location. Examples include vaccines, health screenings, and more.



Can I select which services to access at these clinics?

Yes. All services are optional. You can select the ones you need.



Do I need insurance to access health services at Wellness Clinics?

No. All services are free to the public. Depending on eligibility, the clinic staff can help you enroll in free or low-cost health coverage to get additional health services or follow-up care as needed.



Do I need to complete any paperwork prior to the Wellness Clinics?

Walk-ins are welcome and pre-registration is not needed. Depending on the services selected, you may need to complete some forms. The clinic staff will help you. You will not need to share anything about your citizenship status.





I don't have a doctor I see regularly. Can I still access services?

Yes, you can still access all services offered at Wellness Clinics. If you need help finding a regular doctor, you can get a referral at these clinics.



What do I need to bring to these Wellness Clinics?

Clinics may ask for different information. We recommend the following: Any type of photo ID, your vaccine card (if you have one), and your health insurance card (if you have one).



Do I need to make an appointment?

No appointment is needed. Walk-ins are welcomed!



Can children access services without a parent?

For some services, like vaccines, minors need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian to give signed or verbal consent.



Can someone help me understand my results?

Yes, the medical team can assist you with interpreting your results and can make a referral to a health provider if needed.

These clinics are a partnership between the LA County Department of Public Health and local healthcare providers. All services are provided by licensed medical professionals.
