HOMELESS PREVENTION PROGRAM

Jewish Family Service LA has a team of qualified social workers that will provide support and services to eligible individuals/families at risk of becoming homeless due to hoarding.

What is Hoarding Disorder?

People living with hoarding disorder excessively acquire items and experience difficulty discarding possessions due to causing significant distress. Functional issues may include loss of space, social isolation, family discord, financial difficulties, health and cleanliness issues, etc.

Who is eligible for the Homeless Prevention Program?

- ▶ Older adults age 55+ living with a mental health disorder
- ▶ At imminent risk of eviction due to extreme hoarding behaviors/disorder
- ▶ Currently serving SPA-4 Metro LA area and SPA-5 West LA area

Program services will include:

- ▶ Mental health counseling
- ▶ Teams of Clinical Social Worker (Clinician) and Social Work Assistant (Care Navigator)
- ▶ Intensive case management, including weekly visits from clinician or care navigator
- ▶ Harm reduction approaches
- ▶ Resolution of eviction issues
- ▶ Declutter/cleanout services
