<b>Community Safety Updates</b>	<p><b>SEA</b> – Tended to a homicide near Vermont and Imperial on 7/2. Dealing with rumor control. The victim was a man from Inglewood. Recently, there were 2 shootings near Jesse Owens Park. SEA will be hiring a case manager very soon. Currently working on getting into Woodcrest Elementary to give resources to Parents/Guardians.</p> <p><b>RACE</b> – As of 6/10, the RACE board of directors confirmed Renee Reaser as Interim Executive Director.</p> <p><b>LASD</b> – We welcomed LT Monica Botello to our CAP meetings. LT Botello will be filling in for CAPT Allen temporarily. The murder on July 2<sup>nd</sup> was the 6<sup>th</sup> homicide in the area this year. It was the 21<sup>st</sup> shooting. The Gang and Homicide unit are working on the case. This time last year there were 43 shootings and 9 homicides. The reason for decreasing trends is hard to determine.</p>	Information sharing	Duran
