BUILD SUSTAINABLE INFRASTRUCTURE

- Change hiring and contracting practices to be more equitable and responsive to community and grassroots organizations
- Provide mechanisms to compensate stakeholders in vulnerable communities for their time as advisors through stipends, providing food at meetings
- Coordinate with other departments and initiatives to leverage community networks
- Institutionalize supports for community engagement
