










After declining from 2014 through 2020, the number of new HIV diagnoses among ciswomen hit a 10-year high in 2023. Particularly, new HIV diagnoses are increasing among ciswomen experiencing homelessness.




Number of Female and Congenital Syphilis Cases^{1,2} Los Angeles County, 2010-2021³ (excludes Long Beach and Pasadena)

Los Angeles County saw an all-time high of 136 congenital syphilis cases in 2022 among 133 birthing parents¹.

50% of birthing parents did not


receive any prenatal care.


Birthing Parent Characteristics* of Congenital Syphilis Cases in Los Angeles County, 2022

11% of congenital syphilis cases were stillbirths or neonatal deaths².

13 Stillbirths, 2 Neonatal deaths 121 Live births Of those, 50 (41%) referred to DCFS³



Birthing parents faced major health and social challenges.



*Characteristics are likely under-reported due to loss to follow up and minimal medical documentation.


