This lecture will review the epidemiology of substance use trends among adolescents, along with current advances in science on the short and long-term effects of use on the developing adolescent. This lecture will discuss the current personal, social, and environmental barriers and challenges that prevent adolescents who have or at risk for developing substance use disorders (SUDs) from getting the care they need. The lecture will also highlight developmentally appropriate interventions that have been shown to be effective for identifying and addressing alcohol and other drug problems among adolescents. The lecture will end with featuring a panel to discuss national and local perspectives on current drug policies and treatment implications for adolescents.

By the conclusion of the lecture, participants should be able to:

1. Describe current epidemiology on trends on adolescent substance use;
2. Discuss the current science of adolescent MJ use on brain development and other health effects;
3. Explain how to apply a Brief Intervention for adolescents in primary care settings.
