Timothy W. Fong MD, Director, UCLA Addiction Psychiatry Fellowship

This lecture will provide an updated overview of the scientific and evidence based practices on how to incorporate medicines into the treatment of addictive disorders. Particular emphasis will be placed on describing empirical use of buprenorphine, varenicline, naltrexone, and acamprosate for addictive disorders. Case studies will illustrate how effective use of medicines can provide unique benefits and advantages to improving recovery outcomes. Additional emphasis and discussion will be focused on debunking myths and misconceptions about the use of medicines in treating addictive disorders with the purpose of encouraging all clinicians to think how medication-assisted treatment might be implemented in their respective treatment programs.

By the conclusion of the lecture, participants should be able to:

1. Describe the mechanisms, side effects, and treatment goals of at least three FDA-approved medications for addictive disorders.
2. Discuss at least two advantages and disadvantages of employing medicines in a recovery treatment program
3. Review three case studies on how effective use of medicines can improve treatment outcomes.
4. Explain at least three administrative protocols and processes that are required to implement medication-assisted treatment into a variety of healthcare settings.
