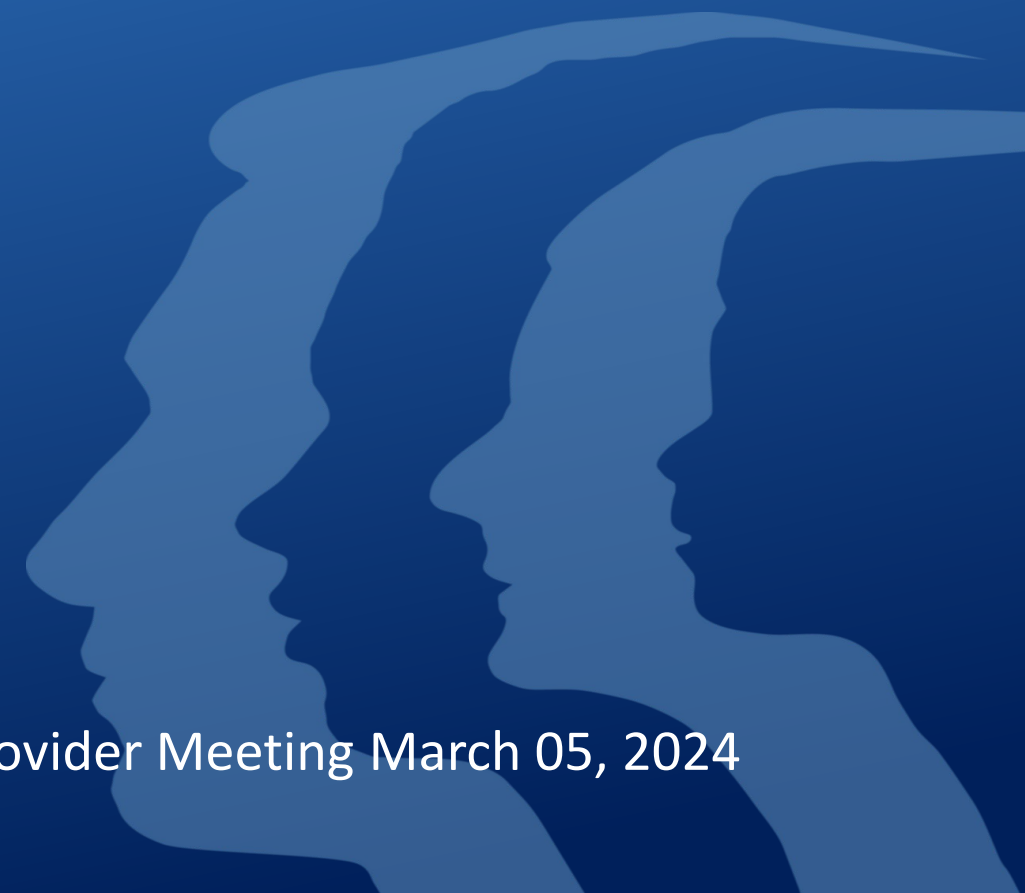

New Allowable Disciplines- Pending Final State Guidance

Clinical Trainee

A Clinical Trainee is an unlicensed individual who is enrolled in a post-secondary educational degree program in the State of California that is required for the individual to obtain licensure as a Licensed Mental Health Professional or Licensed Practitioner of the Healing Arts; is participating in a practicum, clerkship, or internship approved by the individual's program; and meets all relevant requirements of the program and/or applicable licensing board to participate in the practicum, clerkship or internship and provides rehabilitative mental health services or substance use disorder treatment services, including, but not limited to, all coursework and supervised practice requirements.

Important Note: Medical Assistants provide administrative, clerical, and technical supportive services AND **the licensed physician, surgeon, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant must be physically present in the treatment facility (medical office or clinic setting) during the provision of services by a medical assistant.**

New disciplines will be retroactive to 7/1/2023.

SAPC is clarifying allowable codes for each discipline type with the State and will provide further guidance as it becomes available.

Trainee rates will be paid at the same rate as the licensed supervisor discipline rate

- I.e. Psychologist Clinical Trainee rate = Licensed Psychologist rate

The licensed supervisor NPI must be on the claim along with the NPI and taxonomy of the clinical trainee.

- SAPC will be confirming supervisor information with each provider agency and configuring in Sage to include NPI when claiming to the State.

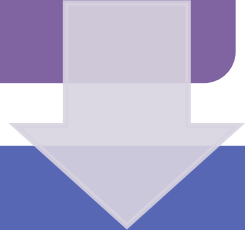
Providers should contact their CRU Financial Analyst located on the monthly Check Remittance spreadsheet for the official amount if needed.

FORMULA for calculating Remaining Contract Amount


Contract Amount - Total Disbursed (After Takebacks) = Approximate amount remaining on the contract

\$15,000- \$10,272.00= \$4,738.00 (Approximate amount remaining on contract)

Recovery Incentives- Contingency Management Updates

When billing RI-CM H0050 codes, the diagnosis must be included on the billed service

- R82.998- Other abnormal findings in urine
- Z71.51- Drug abuse counseling and surveillance of drug abuser

Diagnosis Entry

- For Primary Sage Users either diagnosis must be entered in the Fast Service Entry Submission diagnosis field located in the Recovery Incentives section
- For Secondary Sage Users, either diagnosis must be included in the HBK or HBF segments of your 837
