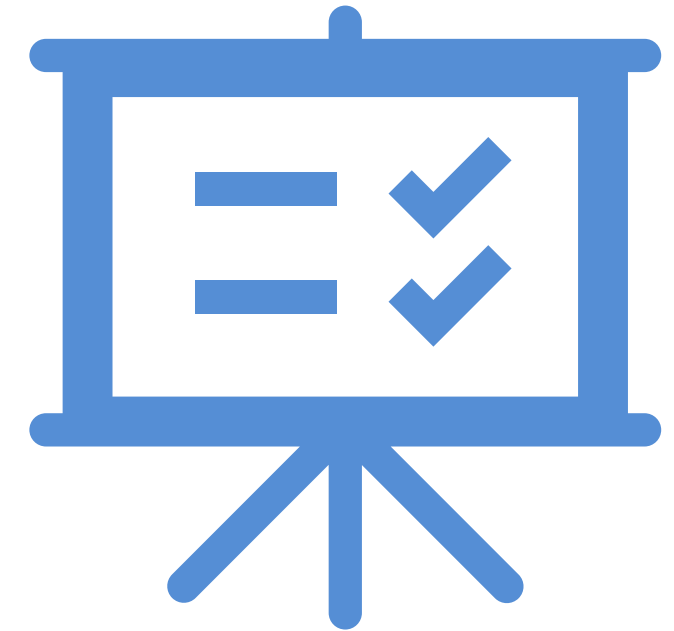

Progress Note Status Report

- Performance issues have been resolved.
- All data fields have been returned to the report output and data is accurate.
- Practitioner parameter issue still being addressed.

Replacement Claim Assignment

- Replacement claims issue resolved to allow primary providers to submit replacement claims as intended.

Fast Service Entry Maximum Units Error

- This denial is not a true denial message.
- Once claim is submitted and processed, the claim will be approved if no other denial is present.
- The final resolution is being validated and will be applied as soon as available.

Metric: At least 75% of patients served agency-wide have a signed ROI form to share with internal (other SUD) or external entities (e.g., physical or mental health) by 3/31/25

Verified through Primary and Secondary Provider use of the [Sage PCNX File Attach](#) form for uploading ROI “File Type” with ROI Internal or ROI External “Document Type”.

Calculation: Numerator is # of patients with a signed ROI uploaded.

Providers can utilize the “Provider File Attach Report” to retrieve total ROIs to determine this number of signed ROI.

Denominator is total # patients served based on the Provider Site Admission form. [Census Report](#) can be used to determine patient admissions.
