Welcome to the Network Adequacy Certification Application! This database allows SAPC treatment providers to submit and update information related to requirements for network adequacy, cultural competency, and the Service and Bed Availability tool (SBAT).

The NACA is required for:

- All outpatient, intensive outpatient, residential and opioid treatment providers under the DMC ODS.


Treatment providers **must keep all sections** including the Organization, Provider Site and Practitioner Level data up-to-date.

 - **Information** must be reviewed and updated for each **site location** and **all practitioners** offering direct services.
 - Only use **Google Chrome**  to access NACT application

 - b. Site Location(s)
 - c. Practitioners Information
 - d. Current and maximum # of DMC patients
 - e. Language Fluency (per site and practitioner)
 - f. Cultural Competence training

April 21 & 23, 2021 – SAPC will conduct on-line training for Provider Point Persons

April 23, 2021 - NACT application opens for all treatment providers to review and input data

April 23- May 12, 2021 – Provider data input and SAPC technical assistance

May 12, 2021 - Submission Deadline - **HARD DEADLINE**

May 13 - 26, 2021 – Data validation. SAPC will contact Agency Point Person with any questions, corrections or clarifications
