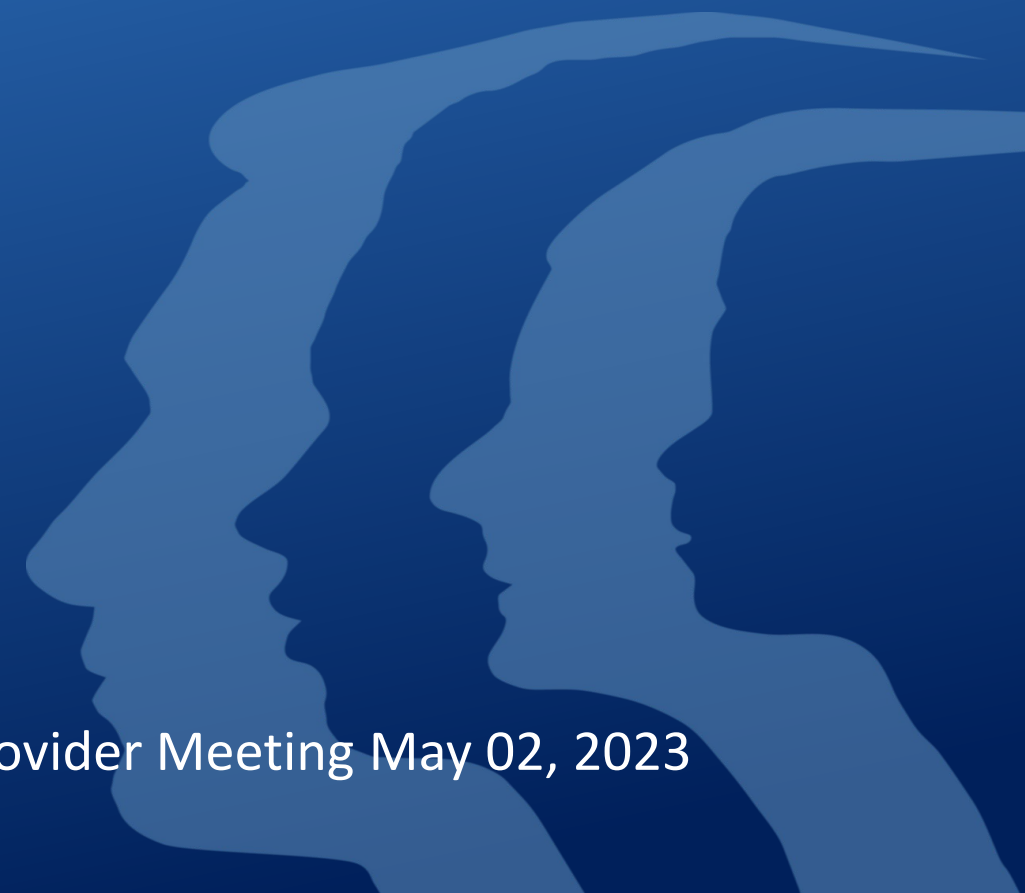

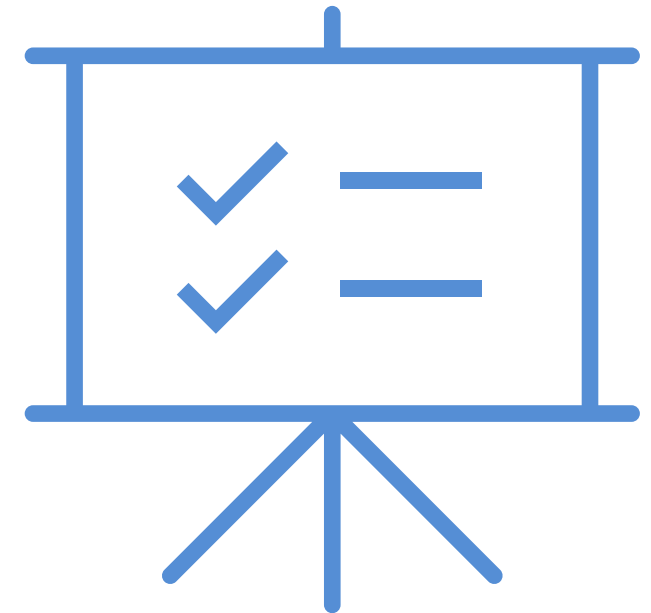

[Problem List/Treatment Plan Form Job Aid for Primary Sage Users](#) The Treatment Plan form was updated to the Problem List/Treatment Plan form which includes a dedicated Problem List to meet CalAIM requirements.

- Key Points: Problem list and required elements were added to the existing Treatment Plan form to consolidate problem list and treatment plan requirements to one form.
- Users have the option to default the most recent submitted treatment plan to the new form and edit what is needed.
 - Please see the job aid for instructions on adding and removing problems.
- The signature field was added in preparation for the Provider Connect NX (PCNX) upgrade, but is not currently functional in Sage-ProviderConnect

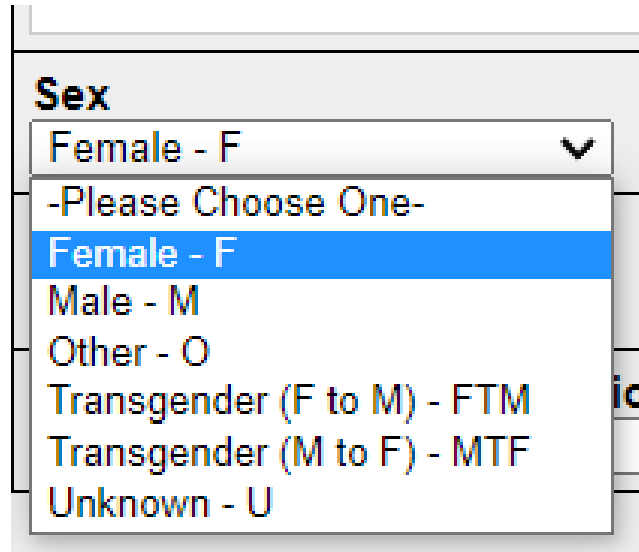
Defaulting from Previous Plan

When defaulting information:

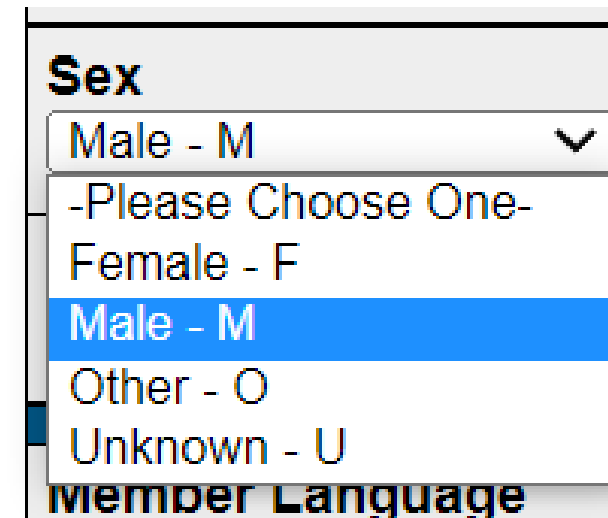
1. All relevant information from the most recent treatment plan will default to the new Problem List/Treatment Plan Form
2. Users will have to re-enter the name in the “Created By” field due to a known error in the defaulting.
3. Because a new Problem Number field was added, users will have to add a problem number to each of the previous Treatment Plan Problem(s) to save the form. This is a 1-time activity.
 - A. An error message will display if the user tries to save the form without the problem number selected for each problem.

- If 'Sex' = 'MTF' (Transgender (M To F)) prior to update, 'Sex' value = 'M' (Male) following the update

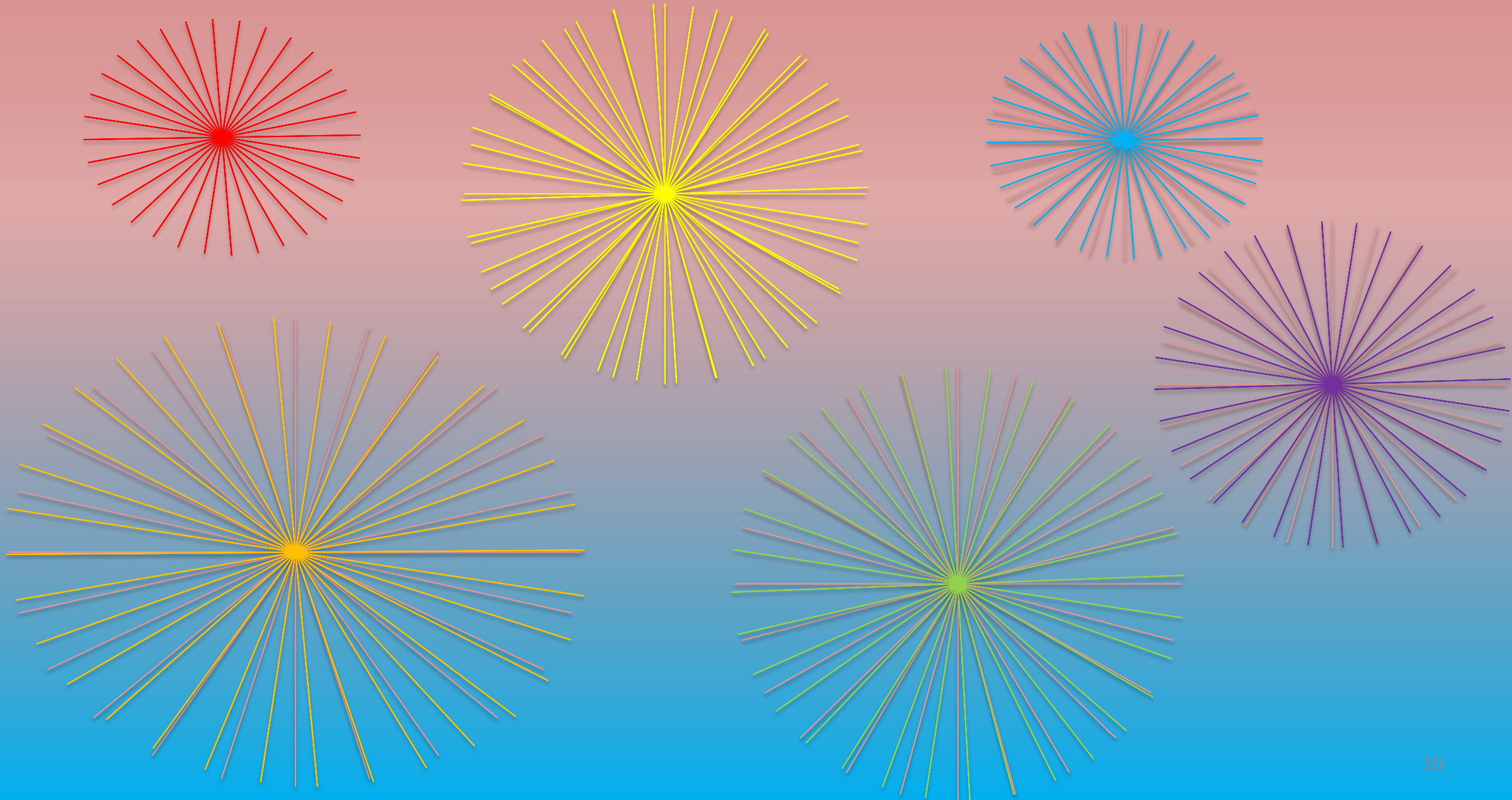

Presenting the Claim Status Report



Used as a 'life of a claim' report for all claims submitted by the provider agency.

Approximately 80 data points about each claim from patient level data to state claiming and final claim status

Starting May 3, the .CSV file will be uploaded monthly to the provider SFTP site and will remain for 14 days before automatically deleted.



PREPARING FOR CAL-AIM



DMC will validate the performing provider for all claims based on the following information:

- Performing provider has an active NPI number within [NPPES](#)
- Performing provider is associated with an approved taxonomy code (pg 119, appendix 1 of the DMC-ODS [Billing Manual January 2023 update](#)).
- Taxonomy codes will be validated against the first 4 characters of the taxonomy for most practitioners.
 - SUD counselor codes will be validated against the first 5 to avoid potential conflicts with other provider types.

SUD Counselor Taxonomy Code 101YA0400X

- DHCS has confirmed that SUD/AOD counselor taxonomy code 101YA0400X will be added to the next iteration of the billing manual expected in May.
- SAPC strongly recommends all SUD counselors (registered and certified) utilize this taxonomy code.**

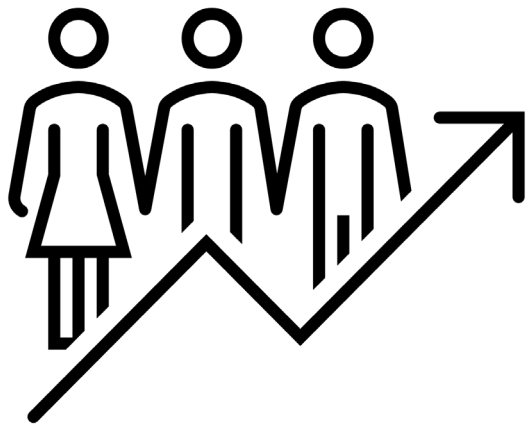
Providers should confirm all performing provider staff:

- Have active NPI numbers
- The taxonomy codes associated with the active NPI is an approved taxonomy code
- The contracts Sage liaison will be reaching out to confirm any NPI and taxonomy code updates needed.



ProviderConnect NX (PCNX)





PCNX will allow SAPC to configure/create new reports, forms and other data views that were previously unavailable in the current version of PCONN.



Users will have different views of the interface when logged in as a Clinical user vs. a Financial user that will mimic a recommended workflow to better match the needs of the user role.



When users log in, they will be notified of draft notes that need to be finalized and have the ability to create personalized “notes to self” similar to a to do list.
