<p>Who Should Attend:</p>	<p>This six-hour training is free and is open to staff who are interested in learning about the ASAM Criteria and Documentation, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Psychologists • LMFTs and LCSWs • Registered Nurses • Certified Substance Use Disorder Treatment Counselors • Other Behavioral Health Specialists/Clinicians • Clinical Supervisors/Clinical Trainers are encouraged to attend, as well, in preparation for future Training of Trainer sessions
<p>Training Description and Core Clinical Components:</p>	<p>This interactive, skills-based, intermediate-level training will begin with a brief overview of the ASAM criteria and a cross-walk between the levels of care articulated in the ASAM criteria and the levels of care defined by the DMC Waiver. Following the brief review of the ASAM criteria, participants will then develop an individualized treatment plan to address the problem areas identified across each of the six dimensions, including long and short term goals, specifying actions steps patients and staff will implement. From the treatment plan, instruction will be given in developing notes that document progress on treatment plan goals. Participants will practice drafting progress notes using a series of case scenarios.</p>
<p>Learning Objectives:</p>	<p>At the conclusion of the ASAM Criteria and Documentation Training (ASAM-B), participants will be able to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Demonstrate ability to apply ASAM risk ratings to information gathered through multidimensional assessment 2. Demonstrate an ability to create an individualized treatment plan based upon the ASAM criteria and risk across the six dimensions of multidimensional patient assessment. 3. Use progress notes to demonstrate movement toward attain treatment plan goals
