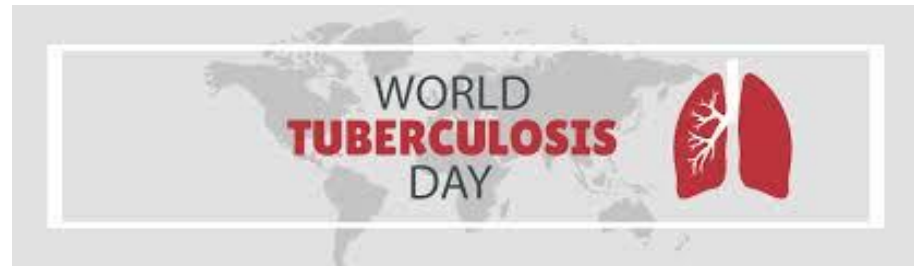

CDC releases new TB resources for Uniting for Ukraine arrivals

- CDC is pleased to announce the release of [new tuberculosis \(TB\) resources](#) to increase awareness about the TB screening and attestation requirements of the Uniting for Ukraine program. CDC conducted a needs assessment with arrivals and community-based organizations and used the findings to develop communications resources encouraging arrivals to get tested for TB. Resources are available in Ukrainian, Russian, and English.
