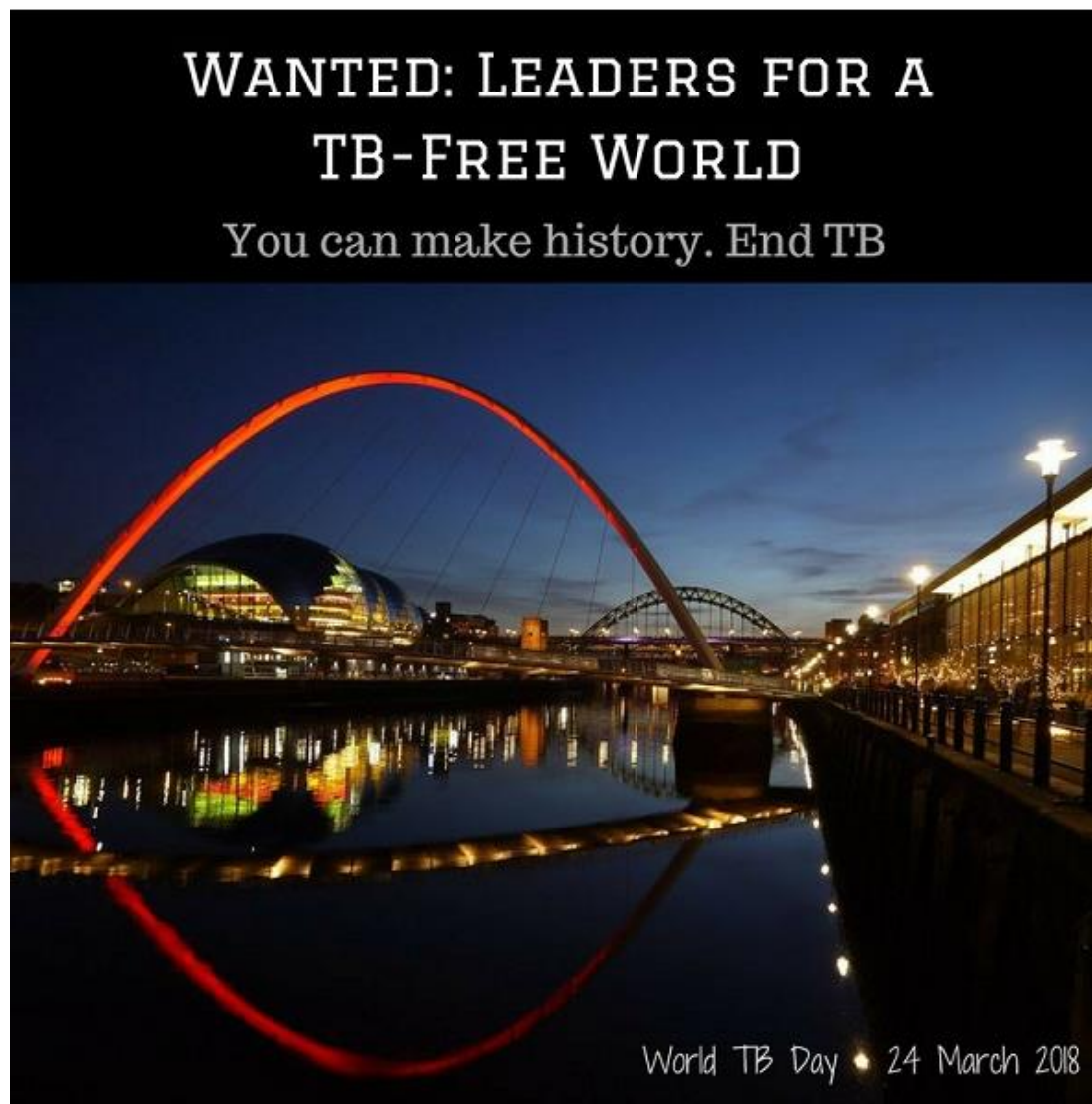

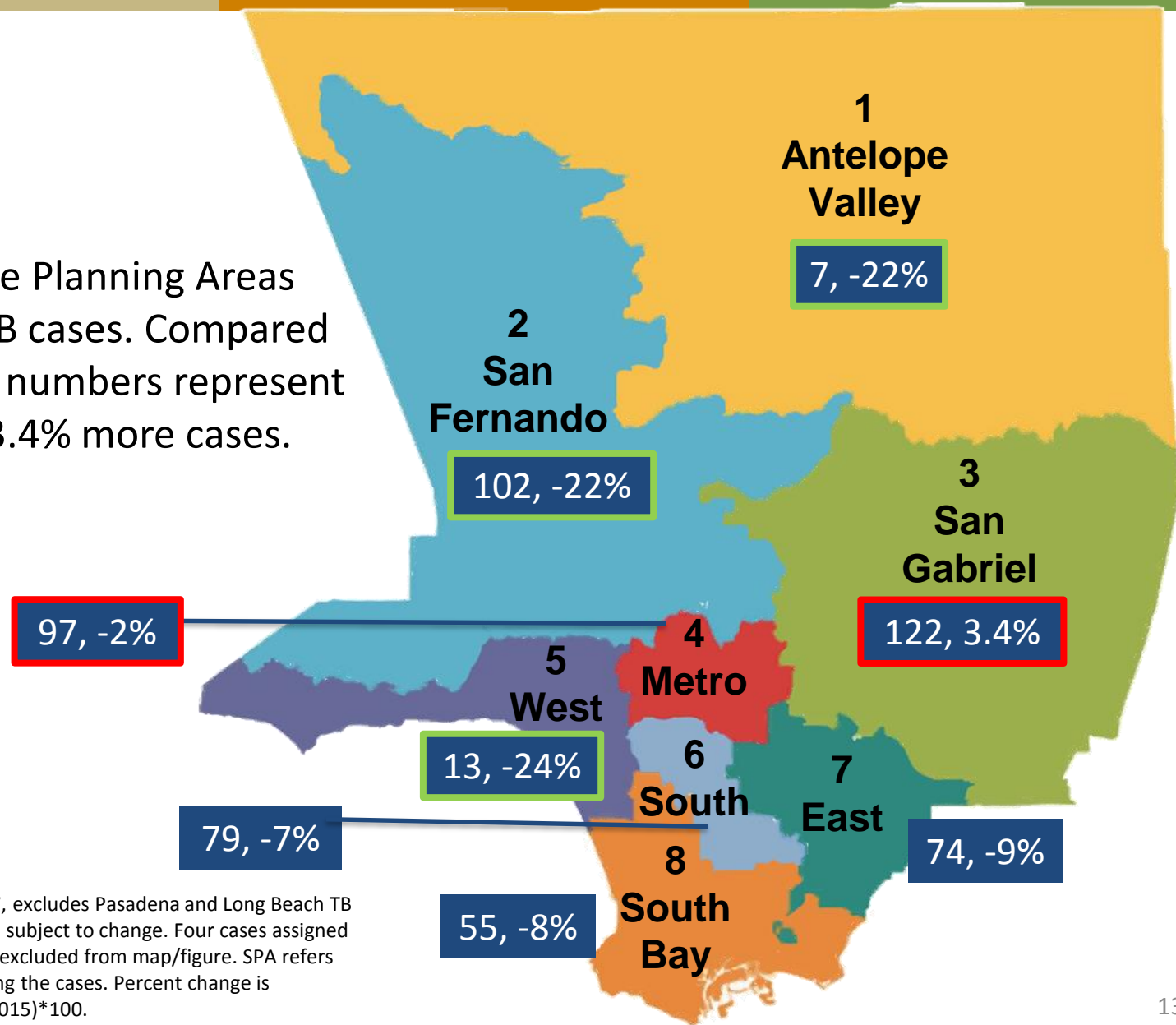

TB Cases (N=553) and Percent Change (-8%) in 2016

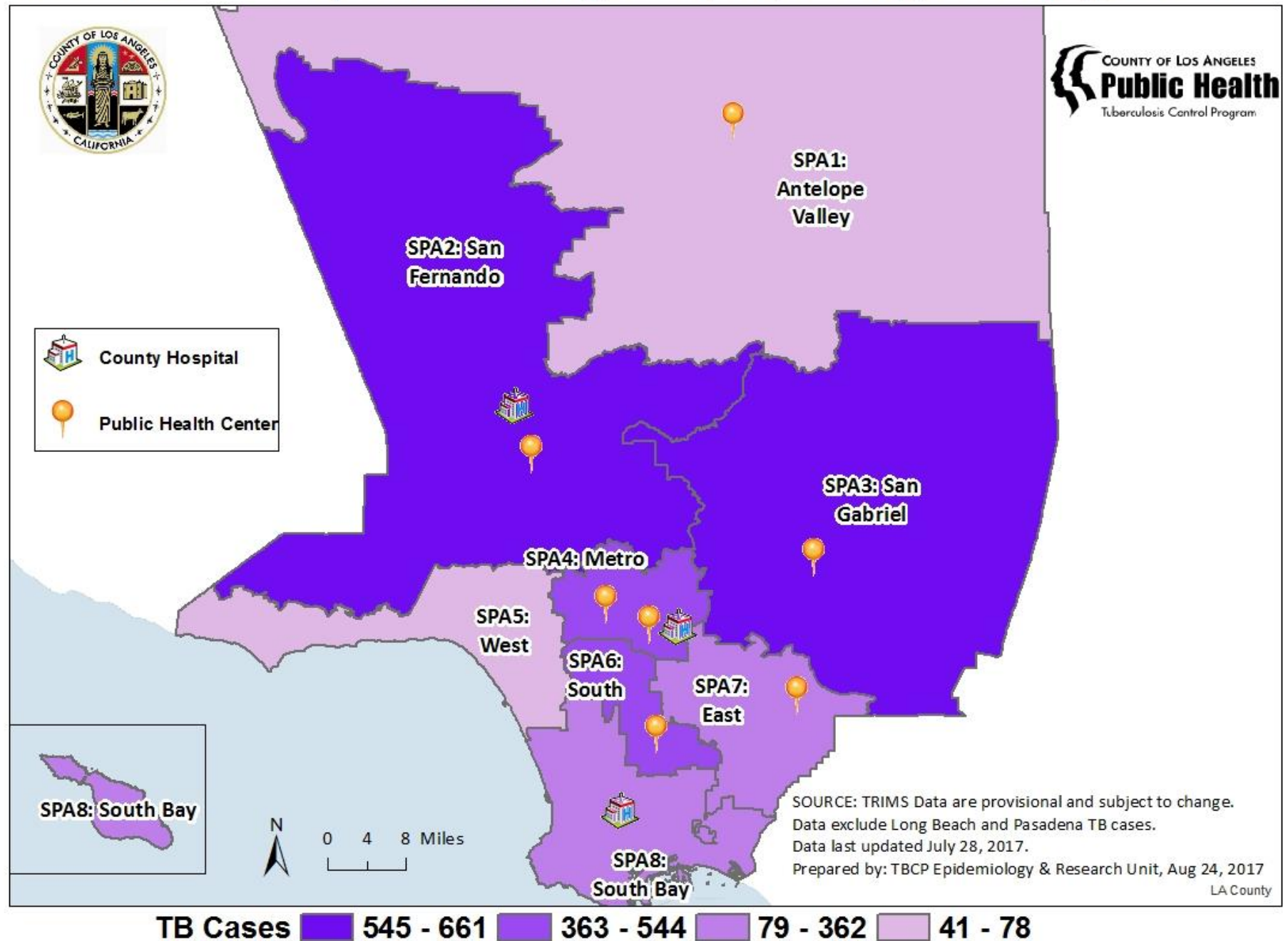


In 2016, Service Planning Areas had 7 to 122 TB cases. Compared to 2015, these numbers represent 24% fewer to 3.4% more cases.

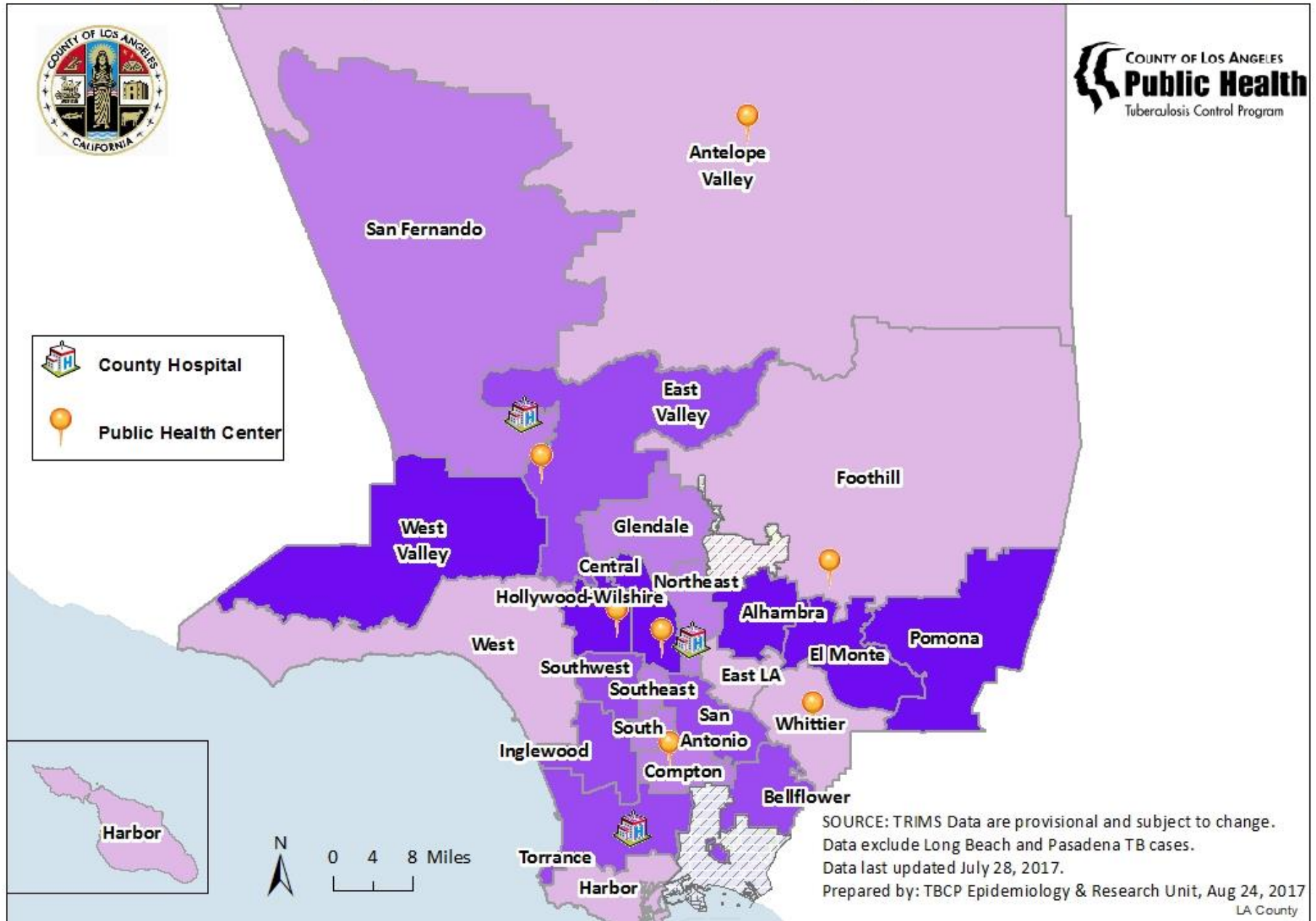
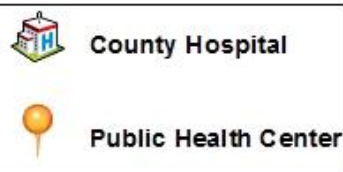

Tuberculosis Cases by Service Planning Areas (SPA): Los Angeles County, 2012-2016



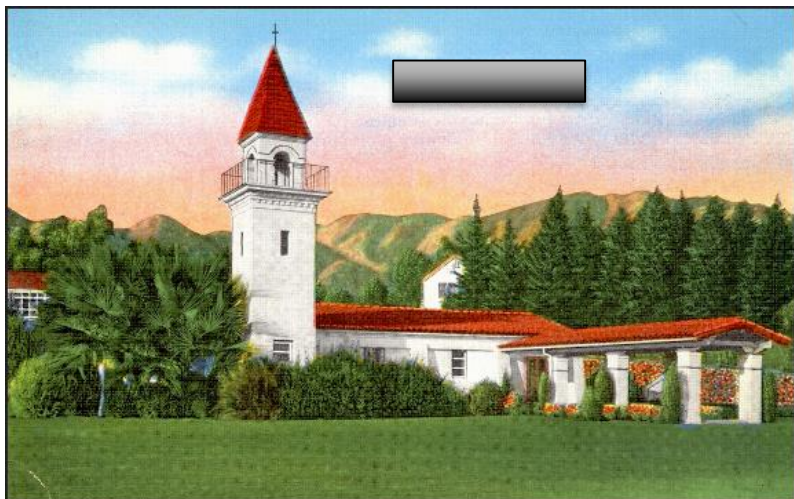
Tuberculosis Cases by Health District (HD): Los Angeles County, 2012-2016



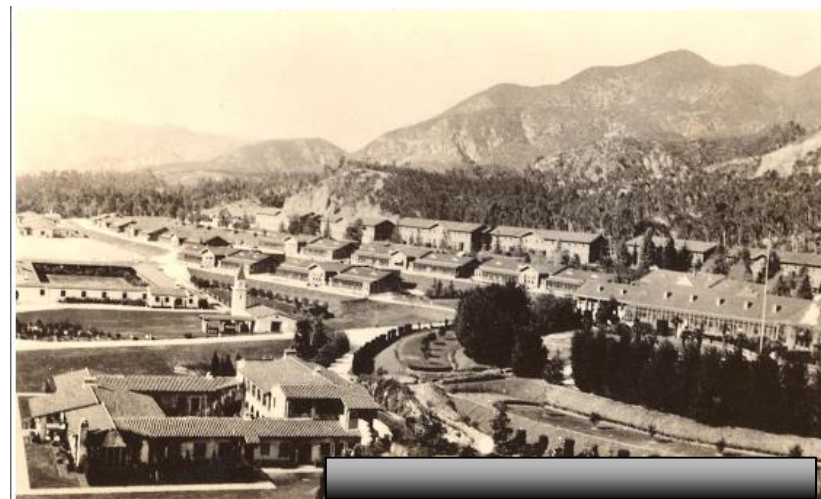

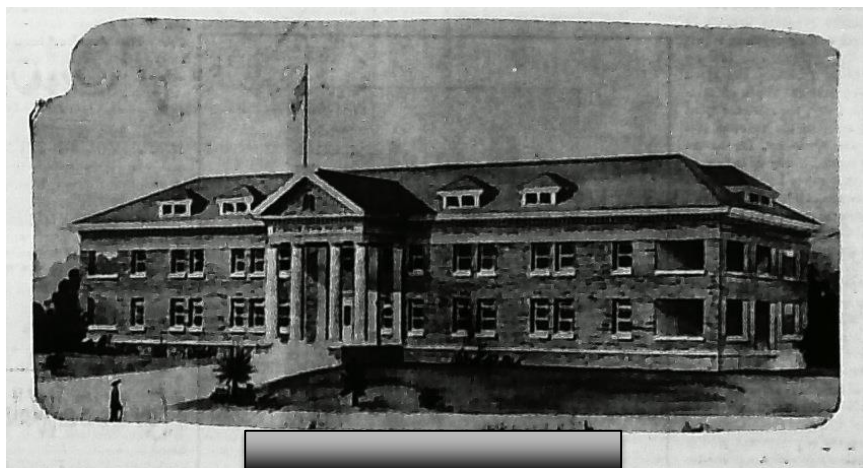

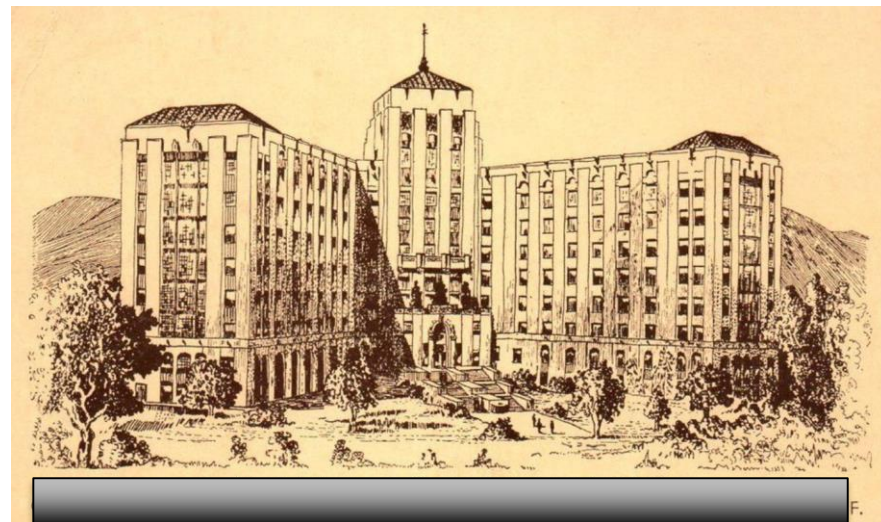
