



**Veterinary Externship Program Training Agreement  
with the University of \_\_\_\_\_ School of Veterinary Medicine**

Over the years, the County has entered into a number of affiliation agreements with a variety of educational organizations. These agreements provide for clinical experience in various health care disciplines.

The agreements benefit the County because the students' training experience includes the provision for assistance in disease investigations at no direct cost to the County.

A new program has been developed to provide 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year veterinary students with hands on experience in veterinary public health in a large metropolitan health department.

The Department of Public Health will be responsible for supervising the students while they are on County premises.

Approximately four students are expected to participate in the program annually. The agreement will commence upon execution and remain in force until terminated by either party.

Fiscal Impact: There is no monetary payment between the parties.
